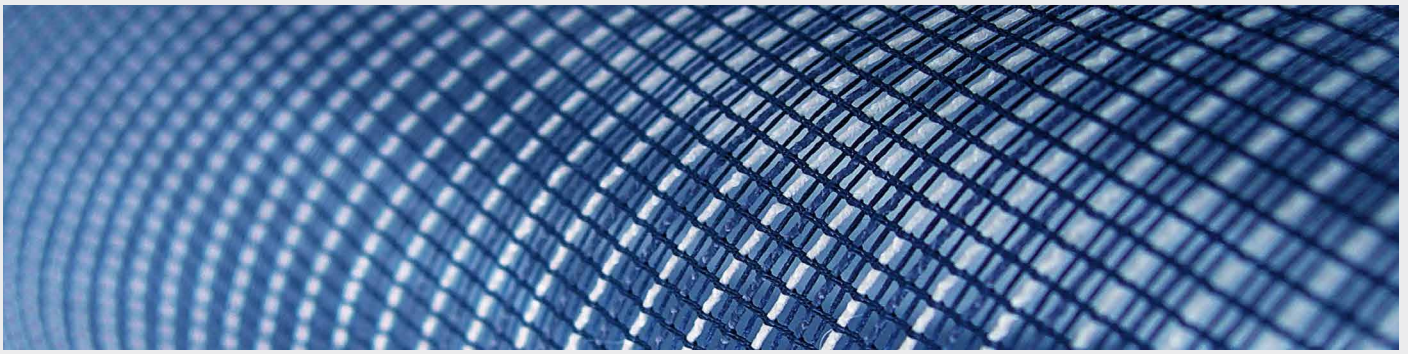
Our fibres and filament yarns possess outstanding functional properties, fitting the demands of the home textiles, automotive and apparel industries, the hygiene sector and technical applications.
